

## Deliver your childcare setting with your certificate of means-tested fee for 2024 for **CHILD** with child code **CODE** to your childcare setting

Dear Parent,

**Deliver the certificate of means-tested fee to your childcare setting by 15 January 2024.**

**You do not need to do this if your childcare setting lets you know not to.**

Your means-tested fee is automatically indexed every year on 1 January. The indexation for 2024 is 4%.

### Where do you find your means-tested fee certificate?

You can find your certificate at [mykindengezin.be](https://mykindengezin.be). (For your privacy, we cannot deliver your certificate by e-mail).

- Choose 'Inkomenstarief aanvragen of simuleren/Request or simulate means-tested fee'.
- Sign in with your digital key (eID, federal token or itsme).
- You can find your new certificate by clicking on the 'overzicht van jouw attestaten/overview of your certificates' tile.

You can also download your certificate in Mijn Burgerprofiel.

- Open your [Mijn Burgerprofiel](#) and sign in with itsme, your eID and card reader, or with a security code via mobile app or text message.
- Open the Certificates and Permits tab and download your Means-Tested Fee Certificate there.
- To keep abreast of new means-tested fee certificates in the future:
  - In Mijn Burgerprofiel, open the Notifications tab (Medlingen).
  - In the upper right corner of it, click Subscribe to updates and manage preferences (Inschrijven op updates en voorkeuren beheren).
  - Enter your e-mail address in updates from Opgroeien. You will receive an e-mail as soon as a new certificate is available.

### Attention: do not make your own calculations!

The means-tested fee for 2023 is the result of several steps: the means-tested fee, the child discount and any individual reduced rate. If you have a child who turns 13 in 2023, they no longer count towards the child discount.
