'Nursery school: is your preschool child ready for it?'

Meeting for parents about preparing your child for nursery school. Your child can start nursery school when he or she is 2,5 years old.

Your child will be looked after in a pleasant environment and spend his or her time playing, drawing, cutting and sticking. Through play your child will learn new words and become fluent in the Dutch language. He or she will play with other children and be able to move around to his or her heart's content. That's how nursery school stimulates a child's development. Children who go to nursery school at the right age find it easier to learn to read and write when they are older.

Do you want to know how you can prepare your child for nursery school? If you do, come along to the parents' meeting organised by Child and Family.

We will sit down together in small groups (8 to 10 parents) and talk about questions such as:

- How does a child grow up from a toddler to become a preschool child?
- Is your child ready for nursery school?
- How can your child's first day at nursery school be a day he or she enjoys?

This will be an informal meeting where you will be able to talk to other parents and ask any questions you want. We hope that by the end of the meeting you will no longer have any worries about your child's first day at nursery school.
