

# Can my child attend nursery?

## From 4 May, childcare nurseries are open to:

- Children of all parents who **need to work outside the home** (at least 1 parent).
- Children living **in a vulnerable or difficult home situation**, including **working single parents**.
- Children for whom **no other care can be found**.

## From 18 May, all children are welcome to return!

Important **arrangements** about the return:

- Make arrangements with your nursery about the best time for your child to return.
- A gradual and safe return is necessary. The nursery will prepare a schedule to this end. You will not be able to return from day one.

## Who is not allowed to attend nursery?

- **Children who are sick** are not allowed to attend nursery.
- If your child falls ill whilst at nursery, you must come and pick up your child as soon as possible.

## Arrangements for taking in and picking up your child:

- Ideally, the child(ren) should be brought in and picked up **by the same person**.
- Always wear **a face mask** (or alternative).
- **Do not enter the nursery's living spaces**.
- **Keep your distance** and thoroughly **wash your hands** before and after bringing in and picking up your child(ren).
