

THE EYE TEST

Your child's eyes will be tested at the 12-month review and at the 30-month review.

The eye test detects most of the factors that give rise to the development of a lazy eye and some serious vision problems. Vision development lasts until the age of 7 or 8. Your child's proper eye development requires that eye problems be identified early and, if necessary, treated appropriately. This way, you offer your child maximum developmental opportunities.

CHILD-FRIENDLY AND FREE.

Kind en Gezin aims to detect eye problems in the early years of life. After that, monitoring is necessary as well. The CLB (pupil guidance centre) provides further follow-up of possible eye problems.

TESTING PROCESS

The nurse will take a photo of your child's eyes. Your child should look straight into the camera to allow for correct interpretation. The device will assess the eyes based on the reflection of infrared light on the retina.

If the result of the eye test is abnormal, you will be referred to an ophthalmologist.
